Subject: Service/comfort animals.

People need a passport in order to travel. It must be obtained prior to travel.

Why not have people obtain a travel certificate, from Canadian Transport Authority, to allow their service animal to accompany them in the passenger compartment?

To get the certificate from CTA, documentation would need to be supplied to CTA to prove that the passengers had the complaint that the service animal was needed for (Doctor certification) and proof of training of the service animal to deal with the complaint (reputable organisation known for training service animals).

Set future deadline for law to take effect-to give people with need too travel with service animals the necessary time to obtain paperwork.

Then no exceptions-no CTA certificate, no travel with animal in passenger compartment.
