Subject: APPR

I object to any airline and all airlines being granted any adjustment, temporary or not to the Air Passenger Protection Regulations.

The present APPR must be enforced previous to the pandemic, during the pandemic and after the pandemic.

I insist that:

1. Airlines should be required to follow APPR requirements to rebook passengers on other airlines.

2. Airlines should have to pay compensation for inconvenience during the pandemic under ALL circumstances.

3. Airlines should NOT be given more time to respond to requests for compensation for inconvenience filed between July 1, 2020 and September 29, 2020 and after.

4. No temporary adjustments to the APPR should be in place.
