I briefly read your Accessible Transportation Discussion Paper, and I'm responding from the point of view of a parent with a child with severe food allergy (allergy to all nuts). In this regard, I highly recommend that all precautions be taken especially on modes of transportation such as planes and buses, where spaces are confined.

I also think that automatic announcements should be made at the start of air flights or long-haul travel on buses, trains, etc. to passengers regarding accommodating people with allergies. This should be done as part of regular announcement, without my intervention. This should be done for anyone, with any life threatening illness, etc.

I'll do my best to try and make my child aware, and do my part in trying to keep him from allergens, but we also need others to take some precautions, especially in situations in which we have no control.
